It's all about celebrating the simple joys and making meaningful connections. Let's slow down, savour life's treasures, and toast to the good life.

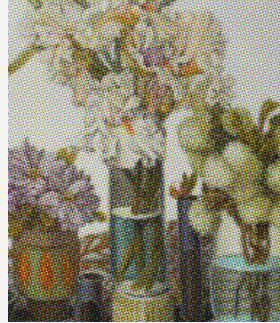

Elevating Experiences Through Art

Sarah Hook, of Fletcher Arts, brings a considered touch to curating the upcoming Good Life Exhibition at All Saints Estate.

Transitioning from co-founding Franque, Sarah now prioritises deep engagement with artists, fostering a dialogue that enriches both the exhibition and visitor experience. “When placing art in a site-specific space for a show, there are many layers to consider,” Sarah explains. “All Saints Estate is a loved family-run business with gravity and warmth, so the art needs to reflect this. The artwork needs to harmonise with the surroundings, and the surroundings need to shine on the artwork – it’s a respectful relationship.”

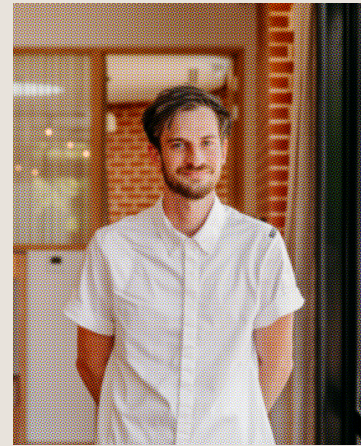
Featured prominently at The Good Life are three distinguished artists. Sam Michelle, known for her floral compositions which imbue still life with personality and narrative. Peter Cole’s monumental sculptures, celebrated in national collections, echo Australia’s landscapes. And Marnie Haddad’s cinematic photography blends Renaissance influences with contemporary themes, capturing emotive narratives within staged settings.

“For me, curating an exhibition is highly personal,” Sarah reflects. “You are part of the process of an artist’s journey, and you need to respect that and explain it thoughtfully in visual terms, authentically.” She hopes that the curated artworks for this event will inspire and enrich visitors, integrating seamlessly with the wine, gardens, and architecture of All Saints Estate. “I believe a Good Life is celebrating those close to you and always being in wonder. Listening, learning, and tasting - it sounds cliché, but I believe it is true.”

On the Pass with Chef Jack Cassidy

Meet Chef Jack Cassidy, recently honoured with a New Regional Restaurant of the Year Award for KIN.



As part of the Good Life Weekend, Jack is set to captivate guests with a showcase of vibrant local spring produce. “Spring signifies fresh ingredients and warmer days,” he enthuses. Emphasising local artisans, Jack will collaborate with renowned suppliers like Markwood Mushrooms, Indigo Valley Lamb, and Spurrell Foraging. “Each supplier offers exceptional ingredients,” Jack affirms. In addition to local partnerships, Jack collaborates closely with All Saints Estate’s Gardener Meg to curate menus inspired by the Estate’s bountiful gardens. “Daily discussions with Meg ensure our menus evolve with the seasons,” Jack adds. “The budding garden sparks continuous planning and experimentation.”

Crafting a menu for All Saints Estate’s 160th Anniversary Dinner, inspired by culinary traditions spanning three centuries, presents a unique and exhilarating challenge. “Researching historical culinary trends and reinterpreting them through a modern lens has been incredibly enjoyable,” Jack reveals. “It should be the highlight experience of the weekend.”

A Journey Through Time and Design



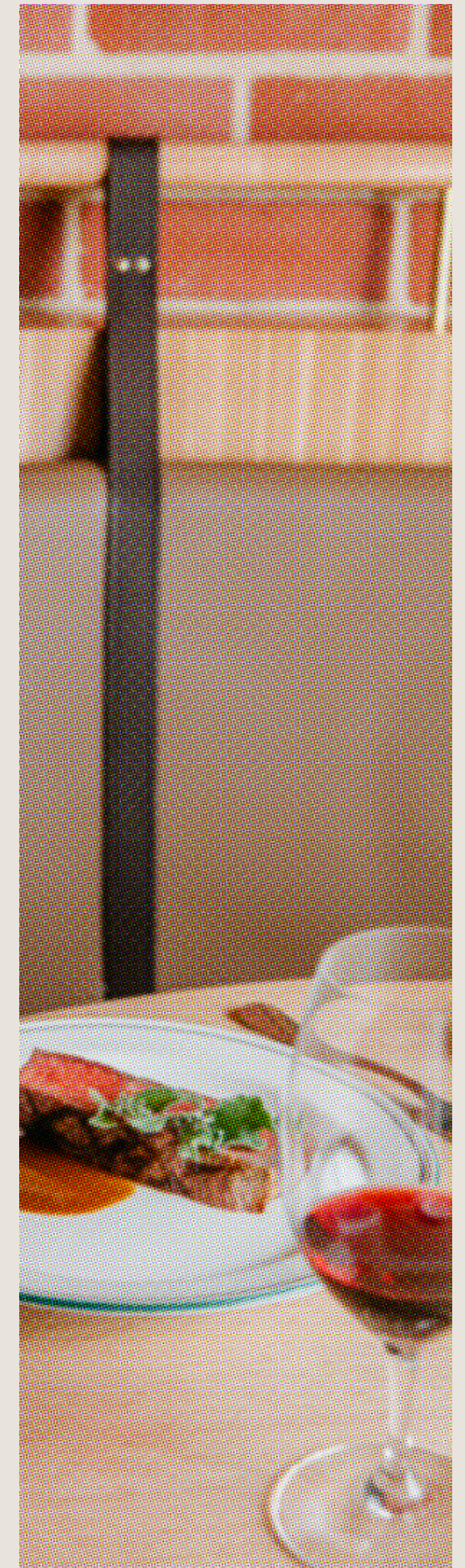
Nestled in serene landscape, Technē Architecture & Interior Design’s recent redevelopment of All Saints Estate blends historical preservation with contemporary innovation.

Owner/Director Nick Travers reflects, “Our goal was to honour the site’s heritage while enhancing the visitor experience with modern hospitality.” Features like the grand castle-inspired main building and new cellar door seamlessly integrate old-world charm with new-age comforts.

Guiding the project’s design, Nick’s colleague Sam Sempill emphasises the balance of preserving history and embracing modernity. “We respect the site’s narrative,” explains Sempill, “creating

designs that foster community engagement.” “As we celebrate All Saints Estate’s 160th Anniversary,” Travers adds, the concept of a good life “is about passion, purpose, and shared culture with family and friends, old and new,” sentiments echoed by Sempill.

Nick and Sam will co-host the Architectural Castle Tour during The Good Life Weekend, offering visitors a design journey through centuries. “We will explore the architectural history of the original buildings,” notes Travers, “showcasing how modern interventions were conceived.” This immersive experience will enrich our understanding of the estate’s past while highlighting its cultural significance today.
