MIXED WINE FLIGHT

2025 VERMENTINO

Check out the schnoz on this bad boy! Seaspray, Anjou pear, oyster shells & lemon warheads. Oof. The palate shows salted pear-skins & finger limes, set within a round, plush mouthfeel & pulled through by smashing, crunchy, bright acidity. We couldn't make a better wine for the food & vibes of the south coast if we tried (we did try).

2024 FIANO

We never play favourites with our babies, but Fiano does receive more than its fair share of our affection. All the joy of Chardonnay, but fresher, brighter and prettier! A buoyant nose of crunchy green apple and lemon curd, the palate rich with citrus, stonefruit, and nuts, a white-floral mouth perfume and a pithy finish.

2025 RUBY'S ROSÉ

A rosé painted in a burnt orange hues. Raspberry compote, juicy watermelon slices, corsage and exotic herbs ground into some delicious powder. Expect a mouthful of sour watermelon lollies, zippy cranberry juice and a big wedge of orange. Fit for all purposes, sipping through guzzling.

2023 NEBBIOLO

This northern Italian variety undergoes wild yeast fermentation with extended maceration on skins and is aged in seasoned Hungarian oak puncheons. The wine offers aromas of rose petals, bright cherry, black currant, and spice, complemented by a rustic, earthy Italian feel, supple tannins, and a long, lingering finish.

2022 CAROLYN'S CABERNET SAUVIGNON

A rich and broody wine with dark chocolate and dark berries on the nose. This wine offers grace and structure, showcasing the finest parcels of Cabernet Sauvignon meticulously selected for its creation. 40% of the fruit parcel is fermented in oak vats, with the remaining in stainless steel. Aged for 12 months in high-quality small-format French barriques, it unveils layers of complexity that unfold with every sip.

WHITE WINE FLIGHT

2025 RIESLING

Wet stones, white flowers, hay in the distance, mandarin juice on your hands. These are the aromas of our 2025 Riesling. Extra time on lees has gently softened the edges off its naturally wild acidity, and gifted us a zippy, moreish, but delicate wine, with the texture of a perfectly waxed surfboard. How's that yellow fruit on the palate?! Would write more, but I've already swallowed it

2025 VERMENTINO

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2025 VINO BIANCO

Notes on the nose of honeydew and rockmelon, green apple slices, mandarin and lemon sherbert. The palate is soft, round and easy-going, a sort of tropical tutti-frutti - think a summer fruit salad chucked in a blender. Arneis brings softness, and with air florals, Albarino gives it the melon/soft fruit character and Riesling brings it all together with bright acidity and a sneaky, under-the radar, building tannin.

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2025 CHARDONNAY

Sometimes you see a Chardonnay and think: 'so this is what the fuss is about'. The Coppabella vineyard in Tumbarumba may just have gifted us one of these in '25. Star-bright and pale straw, radiant with sun-drenched Amalfi lemon, Bickford's lime cordial, and all the creamy, pith-y joy a heart could desire. Fair warning: it's bloody moreish

RED WINE FLIGHT

2024 LITTLE RED NEBBIOLO/PINOT

Tumbarumba Pinot meets Hilltops Nebbiolo: the crossover event we've all been waiting for.

Fragrant, mouth-watering potpourri vibes here - Juicy, red-fruited, light on its feet, with a fine web of tannin that begs for salumi.

2023 'THE POINTER' PINOT NOIR

Grown in the cool climate region of Tumbarumba, wild yeast fermented and matured in premium French oak hogsheads for 12 months. This Pinot is an elegant and somewhat powerful displaying layers of dark cherry and plum, followed by soft tannins and a long finish.

2023 NEBBIOLO

Wild yeast fermentation with extended maceration on skins and aged in seasoned Hungarian oak puncheons. Aromas of rose petals are supported by bright cherry, black currant and spice, complimented by a rustic, earthy Italian feel, supple tannins and a long lingering finish.

2022 CAROLYN'S CABERNET

A rich and broody wine with dark chocolate and dark berries on the nose. This wine offers grace and structure, showcasing the finest parcels of Cabernet Sauvignon meticulously selected for its creation. 40% of the fruit parcel is fermented in oak vats, with the remaining in stainless steel.
