


ST GEORGE Anchorage

Historic Homestead & Horticulture Tour



A rare example of opulence and grandeur for a homestead of the early 1900s, The Anchorage was built in 1903 for Andrew Nixon from local cypress milled at Nixon's sawmill. The unique architecture features large lofty rooms and wide sweeping verandahs perfectly suited to western Queensland living.
