Vintage Conditions: 2010 was a challenging year, with a dry growing season finishing with cloudy weather during ripening. Although most varieties fared well, Shiraz displayed cool climate characters and are bright and fresh wines.

Winemaking: This Shiraz was hand picked from our Reserve Block N. With half of the fruit being crushed and the remainder being tipped straight into the open fermenter for whole bunch fermentation. Maturation was with a mix of new (30%) and older French and American Oak Hogsheads for 18 months.

Tasting Notes:

This Reserve Shiraz is a true expression of our 1976 Block N, planted by our family in 1976. Picked by hand, and fermented in small open vats, with partial whole bunch and wild fermentation, creating a wine with distinct regional characteristics. This Reserve Shiraz has a great life ahead, maybe even 15 years, and we recommend decanting before serving.

Analysis:

- Alcohol 13.5%
- Residual Sugar 0.7
- Titratable acidity 6.2
