2021 FIANO **AUBURN**



After making wine in Clare for almost two decades, these wines are my personal project. I've selected the best parcels of fruit to showcase the regional and varietal flavours in their purest form. Drink chilled with great friends.

Vineyard & Vintage:

Five years ago, Fiano was grafted on to a single vineyard of 30 year old Riesling vines in the sub region of Auburn. Thriving in terra rossa over limestone soils, these vines are vigorous with a healthy canopy, which helps them withstand the heat and dry summer conditions.

Winemaking:

The fruit was harvested in the cool of night and delivered to the winery at dawn where it was destemmed and gently pressed. The ferment was cool and controlled. The resulting wine remained on yeast lees with a small portion in seasoned oak for four months.

What you see:

Pale straw with a soft green hue.

What you smell:

Notes of ripe apples and dried spice. Flinty and complex.

What you taste:

Medium bodied with beautifully intense flavours. Textural with notes of lemongrass and zesty, bright natural acidity.
