FIRST GROWTH - CABERNET SAUVIGNON



2018	98 points Andrew Caillard MW <i>Medium deep colour, Fragrant and evolved blackcurrant, blackberry, cedar/cigar box, hint tobacco leaf aromas with vanilla, toasted almond, Turkish Delight notes. Well concentrated palate with plentiful blackcurrant, blackberry mulberry fruits, persistent fine grainy tannins, attractive mid-palate volume and lovely crème brûlée, marzipan, vanilla oak notes. Finishes chocolatey with excellent mineral length. This is a beautiful Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon with the density, complexity and torque to develop for the long haul. Based on Reynell Selection Cabernet Sauvignon and aged in new French oak for 18 months. The buoyant fruit and balanced structure makes it easy to drink, but its best years are ahead. Drink 2025-2045</i>

Finishes al-dente firm. A classic vintage with lovely definition, density and vinosity. Should develop very well over the medium to long term. Drink now but best 2024-2032</i>

Generous, supple and claret-like with plentiful cassis, blackberry mulberry fruits, earthy notes fine looseknit grainy textures, and well-balanced mocha, vanilla oak. Finishes cedary with fruit sweet notes and attractive mineral length. A very smart Coonawarra Shiraz reflecting vine age, classic terra rossa soils and empathetic winemaking. Drink now – 2020</i>

Finishes claret firm and minerally fresh. Drink now- 2026</i>

TERRA ROSSA - MERLOT



2019	91 points Andrew Calliard MW – Vintage Journal <i>Medium deepish crimson. Dark plum, blackcurrant, dark cherry aromas with lifted white pepper, mocha notes. Supple and fruity with juicy dark plum, dark cherry fruits, firm al-dente tannins and marked / high pitched acidity. Finishes grainy/ grippy firm with persistent juicy fruits. Elemental but expressive. Needs to settle. Hold till late 2021. 14.0% alc – Drink soon to 2026+</i>
